

## Read Me Notes: Abstract

### Xtra Text and Image Boxes: Positioning

This theme contains three templates (available in four different color schemes). All three templates make heavy use of xtra text and image boxes. The positioning of these xtras is highly dependent on the amount of text content on the page, as well as the width of the page title box. The following is a list of xtra boxes that will probably need adjustments made to their position. You can locate and reposition each xtra from within the Layout window, under the *Xtras* tab – select each xtra in the list to view its position and make any necessary adjustments, moving down the list one at a time:

- Subtitle Box: The subtitle box is set to a specific default width that fits within the two squares at the top of the page (beside the page title). If your subtitle text spans wider than the default width, you will need to move the second square over accordingly. Additionally, depending on the width of your page title text, you may need to move the squares and subtitle box over to prevent the title from overlapping.
- Curved Line & Bottom Navigation: The main text of the page is intended to end before the bottom navigation and before the curved line. If your text is lengthier than the templates' defaults, you will need to move the bottom navigation down (including the square bullets which are separate xtra image boxes) as well as the curved line to ensure it falls at the end of your text. You will also need to increase the inside bottom margin of the main navigation menu to make it line up with the bottom of your text content box. Everything else will fall into place.
- Navigation Menu Line: You can turn off the curved line that is on top of the navigation menu if you like. If your navigation items overlap the line, you can either move it down so it falls below the last menu item, or turn it off. From within the Layout window, select the xtra image box called "nav line" and uncheck the check box to turn it off. Using the same method, you can also turn off the second portion of the curve that lies on top of the text content box. This xtra is called "curved line." If you choose to keep both portions of the curved line turned on, make sure they line up with one another.

### Xtra Text Boxes: Text Input

There are three xtra text boxes where you will need to enter your own text from within the Layout window:

- 1) *domain box* - enter your own domain name. Note: if you link this text, the font color will change from white to the link color; you will need to set your font settings to your preferred colors.
- 2) *subtitle box* - enter a subtitle for the page. Be sure to make any necessary adjustments to the position of the square that falls at the end of the subtitle.
- 3) *bottom navigation* - enter your own navigation text here with the appropriate links. The font colors for link and hover are already set to match the color scheme.
