Sidebar Height Adjustments

Any template that contains a text sidebar alongside the main text content box, will probably need adjustments depending on the height of your text content box - the sidebar will need to be adjusted to the same height as your main text box to keep the main text from automatically wrapping around the bottom of the sidebar box.

Album & Text template

If your text content exceeds the height of your photo album, you will need to increase the height of the album to keep the text from wrapping around the bottom of the photo album. Additionally, there is an xtra text box used to create a tagline, slogan, or subheading for the page. You can input your own text into this xtra box by choosing the xtra box called "Tagline Text" from within the Layout window - make sure your text is minimal so that it fits nicely within the orange box.

Home Page template

This template contains a sidebar that holds several xtras. You will need to input your own text and headings into these xtra text boxes from within the Layout window. Click on the 'Xtras' tab to view the list of xtras. Do not move anything. Click on each item in the xtra list, and view the information that appears to the right side of the interface - if it is a graphic, do not do anything with the xtra. If it is a text box, you will see the text field to the right where you can input your own text - be sure to keep the amount of text within the given parameters of each box, otherwise the design will be thrown off from its original and intended layout.

Email Submission Box

Email submission forms utilize php code and can only be used with web hosts that support php on their servers. If you are unsure of whether or not your web server space has the required php support, contact your web host and ask them.

Two templates contain an email submission box – the *Home Page* and *MicroContent* templates. This box is an external HTML file that has a *mailit.php* file associated with it. You will need to enter the email address of where you want the email form to be submitted - the *mailit.php* file contains the destination email address. The files for the email form are included with the theme's downloadable zip file, contained in a folder

called "EmailForm." From the EmailForm folder, select the mailit.php file. Open this php file (using a text editor such as "TextEdit"), enter the correct email address (in place of 'someone@domain.com'), save and close the file. Drag and drop the new php file into the "EmailForm" folder of ShutterBug's *Files* interface (under the Content window). This will replace the old file with your new one. Go to the Preview window, and hit the Send button to upload the changed php file to your server. Be sure to test your form out to make sure the info is being submitted to the correct email address.

MicroContent Page template

This template makes heavy use of almost every available xtra in the Layout window, and has the text content box turned off - meaning any text you entered in the Content window will not show up; the text is all entered using xtra text boxes in the Layout window. As with the *Home Page* template, you will need to enter your own subheadings and sidebar text into the xtra text boxes that comprise the left side bar. For the thumbnail, do not allow any more than two lines of caption text. The middle column can be whatever you want it to be - we have provided a sample of what would fit well and set up the placeholder for you to easily drag and drop a QuickTime movie into the box.

The third column offers an area to insert your favorite external web page (simply input the URL into the text field provided) - the box will display a visual representation of the web page. For the Newsletter box, simply follow the same instructions outlined above in the "Email Submission" box section to input the correct destination email address for the form to be submitted to. If you have already done this, you don't need to repeat these steps - this template uses the same "EmailForm" files as the *Home Page* template.

Collage & Slideshow template

As with the *Home Page* template, you will need to go into the Layout window, and enter your own text for the subheading and sidebar text boxes. The small slideshow display in the sidebar is intended for a maximum of two lines of caption text only. Do not exceed this amount, otherwise it will overlap onto the xtra boxes that follow it - if the caption text overlaps, you will need to move the xtra boxes further down the page.

Slideshow Only template

The slideshow in this template includes xtra "clickable images" for the Previous and Next arrow buttons. These images are external files contained in the Files interface under the Content window. If you modify and export the theme, be sure to export the following files with it, when the menu prompts you:
